The Island of Ischia and Sorrento 9 DAYS: Saturday, October 3-Sunday, October 11, 2026

Called Europe's best-kept island secret, Ischia is a verdant and vivacious island-sized garden in the Gulf of Naples. Join us in October as The Travel Club discovers it gorgeous beaches, quaint pastel villages, a castle unlike any other, natural hot springs – followed by three nights in charming Sorrento. We'll visit the enchanting La Mortella Botanical Garden, the picturesque village of Sant'Angelo and ferry to the colorful island of Procida. Spend a day at the renowned Poseidon Thermal Gardens on Ischia's scenic bay of Citara - highly praised for its extensive thermal pools, beautiful natural setting, and wellness benefits. As we ferry back to the mainland we'll discover Herculaneum - buried by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius - and visit a winery for a tasting and light lunch. The beautiful coastal town of Sorrento is known for its stunning views, charming streets, and vibrant culture. Enjoy a half-day guided visit of Sorrento followed by a pizza-cooking class at an agriturismo. Enjoy the sights of Sorrento on your day of leisure. Visit Piazza Tasso - the main square, bustling with cafes and shops; Marina Grande - a picturesque harbor with colorful fishing boats and waterfront restaurants; beautiful gardens and terraces that offer stunning views of the Bay of Naples and Mount Vesuvius, indulge in a limoncello tasting: Sorrento is famous for its lemons; don't miss out on tasting the local limoncello or take a ferry to Capri.

Spend at day at the thermal park-transfer and entrance fees included, (treatments are at extra cost). Visit to Ercolano for a guided visit of the excavations. Wine tasting and light lunch. Half-day guided visit of Sorrento followed by a pizza-cooking class at a local agriturismo. Day at leisure in Sorrento.

Day 1: Overnight flight from Boston to Rome

<u>Day 2: Arrive Rome - connecting flight to Naples - hydrofoil to Ischia - hotel check-in</u>

After passport control and immigration, proceed to baggage claim. Pass through customs and meet our Tour Manager, who will help you transfer to the hydrofoil crossing to Ischia. Check-in at the **Hermitage Resort & Thermal Spa**. Enjoy a welcome beverage and dinner at the hotel. **(D)**







Hermitage Resort & Thermal Spa

Just 1640 feet from the historic center of Ischia, Hotel Hermitage features a wellness center, and a Mediterranean garden with sun terraces and three thermal pools. All rooms offer a balcony. Rooms at the Hotel Hermitage & Park Terme include satellite TV and cool tiled floors. Each room has a private bathroom with hairdryer and toiletry set. Breakfast is an extensive buffet including sweet and savory food. At the Cinthia dell'Hermitage spa, guests can book beauty treatments and massages. Facilities include a hot tub, sauna, and Turkish bath. WiFi is available in public areas.







Day 3: Ischia touring

After breakfast depart for a full day's sightseeing of Ischia that includes a visit to the **La Mortella Botanical Garden** – an oasis of greenery with sculptures, water lilies and rare plants from around the world. Later we'll visit the picturesque village of **Sant'Angelo**, known for its cliffside whitewashed houses. Dinner tonight at the hotel. **(BD)**

Day 4: Procida Island

Today we'll take the public ferry to Procida island where we'll explore its cobblestone streets, fishing villages and authentic atmosphere. Return to Ischia and dinner will be on your own tonight. **(B)**





<u>Day 5: Ischia - day at the thermal park - Giardini Poseidon Terme</u>


Today we'll indulge in a day of relaxation at the thermal park where we'll enjoy the thermal waters. Transfers to the park and your entrance fee are included. Individual treatments are at your own cost. THE ENTRANCE FEE INCLUDES: saltwater pools; outdoor thermal pools; indoor thermal pools; Kneipp baths; hydromassage, water jets, and cervical waterfalls; thermal showers; use of gardens and terraces; beach access; umbrellas, deck chairs, and sunbeds; changing rooms and showers. Dinner will be on your own tonight. (B)

Poseidon Thermal Gardens is the biggest thermal park on the island of Ischia: highly curative thermal waters feed over twenty pools surrounded by greenery, three sea water pools for swimming, a thermal steam grotto in the Greek-Roman tradition carved into the tuff, three alternating temperature baths to aid circulation and a cardiovascular exercise course for the lower limbs. There is also a private beach.



Day 6: Ischia - transfer to Sorrento

Depart the island by ferry for the mainland. Enjoy an exploration of the excavations at Ercolano/Herculaneum. Later we'll visit a winery for a wine tasting and light lunch before we head to our accommodations in Sorrento at Hotel Cesare Augusto. (B L)











Grand Hotel Cesare Augusto, Sorrento

The Grand Hotel Cesare Augusto has spacious rooms, panoramic views, and a rooftop garden with swimming pool. In a central position in Sorrento, the beach is just a 10-minute walk from the property. Wi-Fi is free throughout. The Grand Hotel's 120 rooms have air conditioning, a satellite TV, and a minibar. Each has a private bathroom with a hairdryer and bathtub or shower. Breakfast is a varied buffet, and tasty snacks are available at the bar throughout the day. The restaurant specializes in regional and international cuisine. From the Cesare Augusto, you can walk to the nearby Piazza Tasso, and enjoy shopping in the many boutiques that surround the hotel. Guests are close to public transportation and the Circumvesuviana train.

1. Explore Piazza Tasso

2. Visit the Marina Grande

Enjoy fresh seafood at local restaurants and take in views of the colorful fishing boats.

3. Stroll through the Historic Center

Wander the narrow streets filled with shops, artisan boutiques, and historic buildings.

4. Visit the Sedile Dominova

Explore this beautiful historic building, which is a great example of Sorrento's architecture.

5. Enjoy the Views from Villa Comunale

Relax in this public park that offers breathtaking views of the Bay of Naples.

6. Day Trip to Capri

Take a ferry to the stunning island of Capri, known for its cliffs, shops, and the Blue Grotto.

7. Explore the Museo Correale di Terranova

Discover a collection of Neapolitan art and artifacts in this beautiful museum.

8. Try Limoncello


Sample the famous local lemon liqueur, often made from the large lemons grown in the region.
